PCHA partners with HUD to host Labor Standards Training

PINELLAS COUNTY, FLORIDA – The Pinellas County Housing Authority (PCHA) is hosting two Labor Standards Training Workshops on behalf of the Housing and Urban Development (HUD) Office of Labor Relations. These half-day workshops will be held on September 21st and 22nd at the Authority's central office in Largo and will educate attendees on Federal labor standards requirements. The workshops are targeted for housing authorities across Florida, as well as city and county employees who will oversee reporting on federally funded construction projects.

All federally funded construction and repair projects require transparent record keeping and meticulous reporting. The award of stimulus money to various agencies across the state has sparked a need for training in procedures and the administration of these projects.

The workshops will present information about agency and staff responsibilities; how to select appropriate project wage decisions and how to apply them; how to review project payrolls; reporting requirements; and, work classifications, investigations and wage restitutions.

These workshops are necessary for those staff responsible for administering and enforcing Federal labor standards compliance on public housing authority construction and repair projects. PCHA is honored to host these workshops for housing authorities and municipalities statewide.
