Rainbow Village is accepting applications for 3, 4, and 5 bedroom apartments.

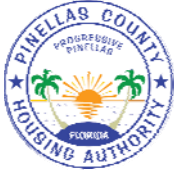
French Villas Apartments is accepting applications for 1, 2, and 3 bedroom apartments.
